

Following our successful reopening in June, we are now restarting the Legacy Campaign and inviting interested supporters to participate! The Campaign initially started last July as a quiet, private campaign in support of a new building addition which had very successful results. The Campaign then moved to the public phase in January of this year with the Neighborhood Gathering Event, which had over 200 neighbors and supporters in attendance. Unfortunately, the COVID-19 pandemic and shut down significantly slowed/stopped the progress of the Campaign.

Construction of the \$3.8 million, 21,803 square foot building addition was able to begin in May, largely due to the early donations received. However, additional campaign support is still needed. There are still many opportunities for small or large donations. One such opportunity will be a “matching” gift program which is soon to be announced. Partnering with the Troy Foundation, the Legacy Campaign will be offering this program made possible through the generous \$100,000 donation of a LCC Legacy major donor.
